### MOST CLASS REQUIREMENTS

- Glue (fine-tipped bottle best)
- Paper Quilling Strips (for use with demos or just to have extra)
- Pointed Tweezers
- Quilling Tool(s)
- Quilling Board/Mat
- Ruler
- Scissors

During the free quilling time you might like to make a butterfly for the Butterfly Project sponsored by The Holocaust Museum Houston. There will be a class on butterflies to help you along.

CLASSES WITH AN ASTERISK (\*) WILL REQUIRE ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES YOU NEED TO BRING TO CLASS.

**\*3D CONE SHAPED TREE - Marianne Fassett**

You will make a cone shaped 3D tree that you can decorate. The technique can be applied to other shapes also. Please bring a package of holiday green 1/8 inch paper.

**MATTING AND FRAMING - Lois Brandt-Weber**

Have a frame that's not deep enough? We can fix. Picture won't fit frame? We can help. Picture need a little oomph. We can help. Bring your problems to the NAQGCON '10 and we'll fix it.

**SPIRELLI - Carol Gancorz**

What is spirelli? It is a form of String Art. Have fun using a combination of spirelli and quilling to make a card.

**\*FEATHERING - Betty Tremaine**

This class will demonstrate how to make incredibly fine feathers by doing narrow cutting and produce a bird. Participants should bring very fine curved manicure/cuticle scissors with very fine point, regular scissors, pencil and a ballpoint embossing tool with small ends are also required.

**\*FEATHERING 2 - Betty Tremain**

The class is the advanced Feathering class. This class will demonstrate how to make incredibly fine feathers by doing narrow cutting and produce a bird. Participants should bring very fine curved manicure/cuticle scissors with very fine point, regular scissors, pencil and a ballpoint embossing tool with small ends are also required

**SUNFLOWERS - Janet Hovanian**

Create a bouquet of sunflowers to be put in a vase filled with Long Island sand.

You will be given a container to transport your bouquet.

### **BRAIDING AND PLAITING - Bobbye Singer**

You will learn how to do Bobbye's famous swan's neck with four strands of paper. You will also learn how to make a plaited basket for a card and use braiding for trim on the basket.

### **IRIS FOLDING MEETS QUILLING....New York Style! - Marion Bertaut**

Create a New York memory while learning about Iris Folding. It would be helpful to Google Iris Folding to get an idea about this craft. You will not only learn about Iris Folding but some interesting facts about New York.

### **PAPER QUILTING - Marion Bertaut**

### **\*STENCIL QUILLING - Charlotte Canup**

Make an Artist Trading Card (ACT) using an interesting technique where the quilling is glued behind a stencil cut-out instead of on top of a background. You will find yourself looking at quilling shapes in a different way. Please bring an Xacto knife if you would like to cut your own stencil, however, since airlines prohibit these as carry-on items (they can be carried with checked bags). I will have pre-cut stencils available.

### **BUTTERFLIES - Kay Charles**

There are many ways to make a butterfly. Find out some hints and tips in this class while making a butterfly.

### **TERN, TERN, TERN - Sue Palmer**

These birds are a common sight at the shore. In this class you will be making little birds on driftwood.

### **MRS. SNOWMAN - Yvonne Pineiro**

You've heard that behind every good man there is a good woman. Well, that also applies to snowmen! They are nothing without a good woman behind them. Mrs. Snowman is a modern, fashion conscious woman who takes good care of herself. This workshop reveals how "less is more".

### **LIGHTHOUSE - Kim Loh-Bodor**

Lighthouses are a symbol of Long Island. In this class you will construct a lighthouse to be put on a card.

### **BEAD QUILLING - Joann Loh**

Try your hand at this new aspect of quilling. This project will identify your scissors. Curious?

### **ALTERNATE SIDE LOOPING AND HUSKING - Kay Charles**

This class is excellent for beginners who want to learn a new skill or experienced quillers who would like a refresher course.

### **SAILING SAILING.....- Kay Shockley**

You'll be making a sail boat and having it float across the waves of your card.

### **FLORAL MOTIF - Yvonne Pineiro**

Color, Color, Color! Spring is here and it is the perfect time to focus on the beauty of nature. Take your quilling everywhere with you so you can find some inspiration in the outdoors resulting in this simple yet elegant floral motif. This design can be used on cards, in scrapbooks or frame it and give it as a gift. In this workshop you will learn the importance of consistency in your pieces and how simplicity can add elegance to your finished pieces.

**TREASURES, TREASURES - Allison Bartkowski**

Would you like some place to keep your tiny treasures? In this class you will be able to make a place for that special little treasure.

**MINIATURE ROSES - Motoko (Maggie) Nakatani**

In this class Maggie will teach us an easy way to make rose miniatures.
