

North American Quilling Guild Conference (NAQGCON) Competition Guidelines 2010

General Rules and Guidelines for Competitions

All NAQG members are encouraged to participate in the NAQGCON competition. If you are not attending the conference you should still consider submitting your work. All competition pieces will be displayed and shipped back to you. You must be sure to pack your piece(s) carefully with the proper packing and return postage for your piece(s) must be included. Please note that your name or other identification is **not permitted** on any piece(s) entered into the competition. If your piece(s) are signed, the signature must be covered before judging.

If you **are** attending the NAQGCON you can send in your competition registration when sending in your NAQGCON registration. If you **are not** attending please be sure to **pre-register** for the competition, this will allow the NAQGCON committee to better judge space requirements needed for displaying competition piece(s).

There will be six categories for competition at the 2010 NAQGCON. Each category will have three levels - a **beginner's level** (those NAQG members who have been quilling for less than 2 years), an **intermediate level** (those NAQG members who have been quilling for more than 2 but less than 5 years), and an **accomplished level** (those NAQG members who have been quilling for more than 5 years). NAQG Members may enter as many categories as they wish, but may only enter 1 piece of work per category. First place winners of the previous year NAQGCON (AGM) will not be eligible to enter a piece in the category and/or the level in which they won first place, however they may enter piece(s) in that category in a higher level and they may enter all other categories (This rule does not apply to the People's Choice Award). **All entries must have been created within the last year.**

Categories

Quilled Cards

1. Must have/follow "**Sun, Sand and Sea**" theme.
2. Must be made from quilled paper strips, glue and card **ONLY... (NO WRITTEN, PRINTED WORDS, AND NUMBERS, ETC.)**

Free Standing Quilling

1. Must be made from quilled paper strips, & glue **ONLY**
2. Must be completely self-supporting.

Framed Quilling

1. Must be made from quilled paper strips, glue, and backing/matting **ONLY... (NO BEADS, WIRE, AND PINS, ETC.)**
2. Frame may consist of any material.

Miniature Quilling

1. Total size including any display materials, **MAY NOT EXCEED 4" x 4" x 4"**.
2. Entries may be single stand alone piece(s) or a group of piece(s), **so long as the size restrictions are met.**

Quilling and Beyond

1. Quilling attached to or adorned with other materials, **the majority of the piece must be quilling.**

People's Choice Award

1. **Every** piece(s) of work entered into the competition will be eligible for this award.

Selection of Winners/Awards

Winners are chosen by members of the NAQG in attendance at the NAQGCON. Members will vote for the winners in each category on all levels including the people's choice award.
